The old air compressor at station two burnt-out; it has been replaced with a new one placed on the floor near 60-13. They will unhook the old air hose from the ceilings.

Truck 60-13 will be going to VRS for repairs sometime in June. Repairs should take about a week.

They will work on 60-35 in house.

Chief would like to purchase fittings for 60-13 and 60-35 at \$204.00 a piece.
